



STEPPE NOMADS tourist camp

Riding a camel – the sand ship



Day 1. Arrive at the Steppe Nomads tourist camp in the morning. Then drive to nearby nomadic family and start riding your camels to Mt. Baits to view the endangered wildlife such as Wild Mountain Sheep - Argali and white napped crane in the Tsengiin Burd. Return to the tourist camp and enjoy traditional Mongolian dish Khorkhog for lunch. Khorkhog is roasted mutton/beef with hot stones in hot pot and served with rice and vegetables. After

lunch, ride your camels to the birthplace of D.Natsagdorj, the father of Mongolian contemporary literature which is just 4km from the camp in the north east.

Have a hot shower and enjoy your dinner at open air. Overnight in traditional Mongolian Ger **L + D**

Day 2. Free morning for your leisure. After lunch drive back to Ulaanbaatar **B+L**

Price: this is not a package tour, so you should estimate your own cost choosing from separate services below what to include and exclude in your tour.

Camp stay: 60 USD per person including 3 meals a day per tourist

English speaking local guide: 8 USD per day (a local guy/girl speaks basic English)

Camel riding: 20 USD per person/day

Camel wrangler: 8 USD per person/day

Binoculars: 5 USD per person/day

Khorkhog: 5 USD per person added on ordinary dinner rate

Nomadic family visit: 5 USD per person

More fun activities like horse, camel riding, yak cart travel, kayaking, biking and fishing are available upon your request and these are paid on spot in cash to the camp manager.

We offer transfer between the camp and Ulaanbaatar upon your request. Also you can arrange your own transportation.
